The seller may have multiple ads at the same time, so sending a vague I want message doesn't help any of you. While sellers who use Craigslist generated by anonymous email will have their listing address displayed in the subject line of the message, including a detailed response will still help you set the response apart. Enter the item you want and ask any questions before closing the sale. If the research on the item turns out the asking price is too high, ask if the seller takes a lower amount, as sellers are often willing to negotiate. Send back the answers to the seller in time so that your interest is not ignored for the benefit of another buyer. Never give out personal information, such as your home address or financial information, by email or phone. After communicating with the seller and deciding to purchase an item, follow some common courtesy and security precautions to ensure a smooth transaction. If possible, choose a public exchange location that is convenient for both you and the seller, such as a store or gas station. If you live a certain distance from each other, asking to meet halfway between the sites offers a fair compromise.
